

(Luke 9:11)

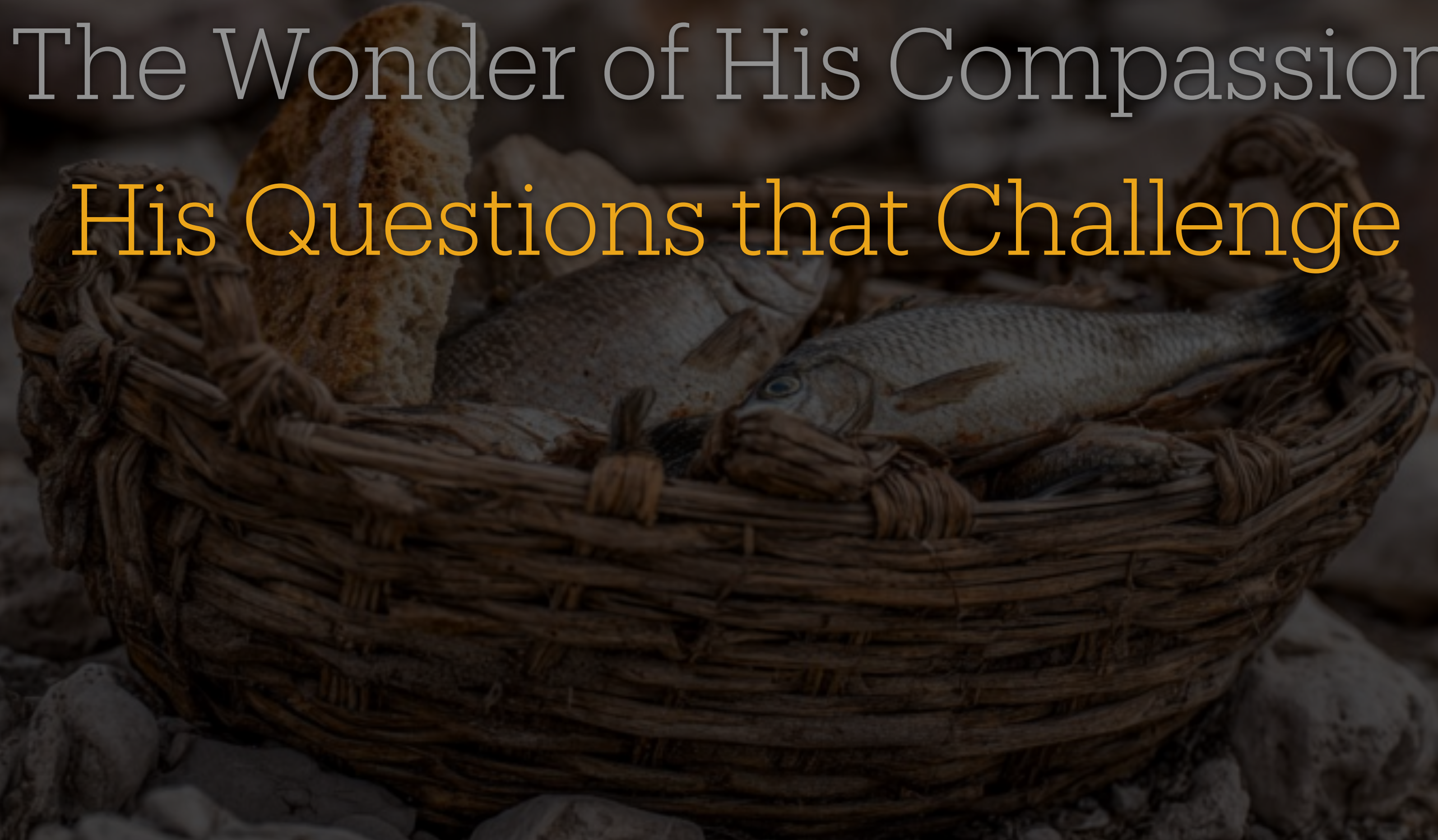
Matthew 14:14 - “He was moved with compassion for them” (Matt. 14:14)

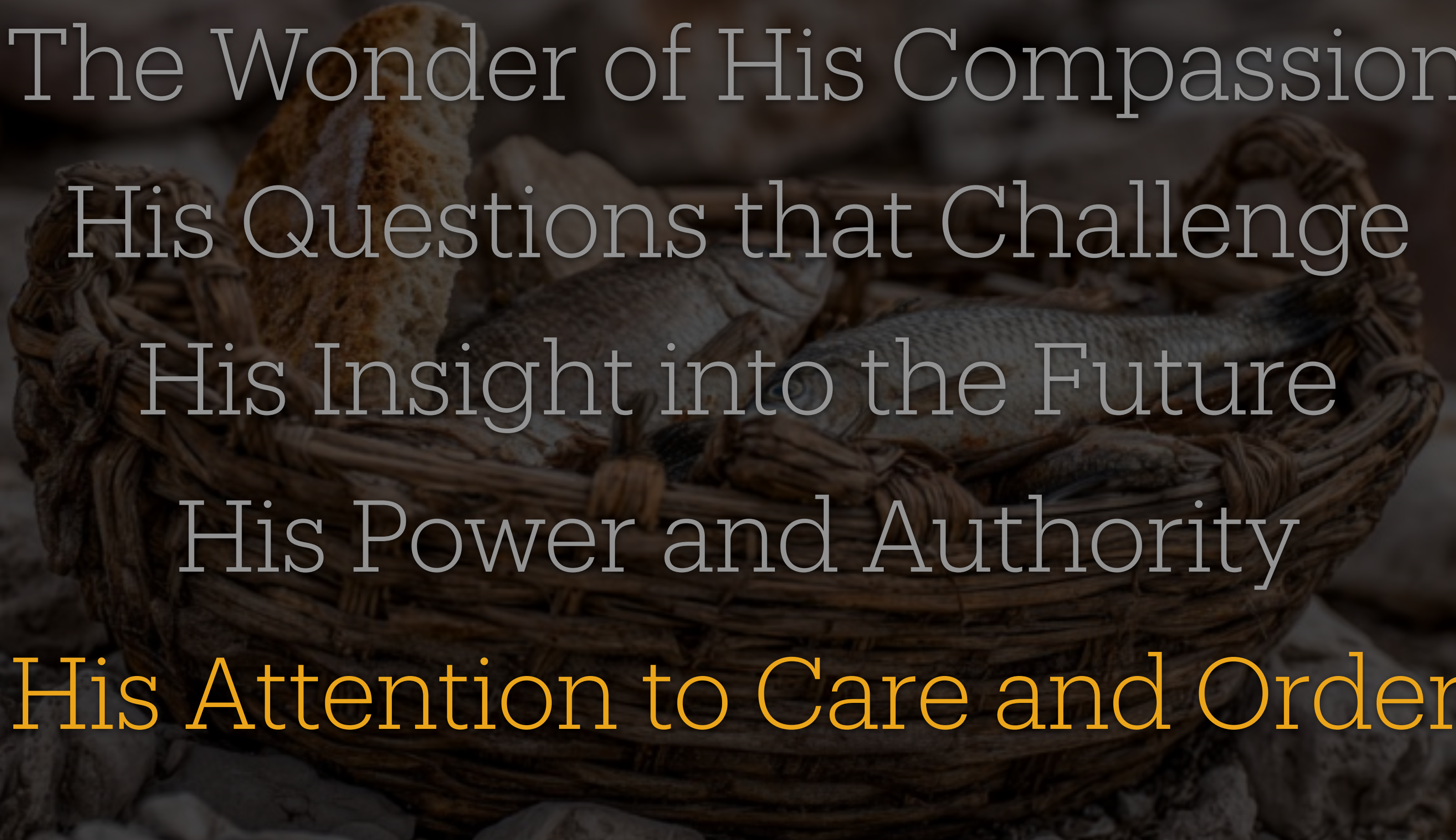

Remember God is a God of order & not of chaos (Gen 1:11-29; 1 Cor 14:33)

"Make them sit down in groups of fifty" (Luke 9:14)

"Then He commanded them to make them all sit down in groups on the green grass. So they sat down in ranks, in hundreds and in fifties" (Mk 6:39-40)




