POINT #1: We Must Own Up to Sin.

- **DAVID DID NOT BLAME OTHERS FOR HIS SIN.**
 - ADAM **GENESIS 3:12**
 - AARON **EXODUS 32:22-24**
- **DAVID DID NOT USE EXCUSES. JEREMIAH 17:9**
- **DAVID DID NOT EMPLOY SITUATIONAL ETHICS.**
PROVERBS 28:13

POINT #1: We Must Own Up to Sin.

“AND THE LORD COMMANDED US TO OBSERVE ALL THESE STATUTES, TO FEAR THE LORD OUR GOD, FOR OUR GOOD ALWAYS, THAT HE MIGHT PRESERVE US ALIVE, AS IT IS THIS DAY.”

DEUTERONOMY 6:24

POINT #2: We Cannot "SOFTEN" Sin.

- WE MUST NOT RATIONALIZE OUR SINS.
 - ACCEPTS RESPONSIBILITY, **PSALM 51:3-4**
 - FREELY OWNS IT (SIN-ACTIONS, GUILTY-FEELINGS, SELFISHNESS), **PSALM 32:5**
- WE MUST NOT REDEFINE OUR SINS.
 - ISAIAH 5:20; ROMANS 1:18-32**
 - LUKE 18:13**-PUBLICAN'S FEW WORDS
- SIN PUT US IN DIRECT CONFRONTATION WITH GOD,
2 SAMUEL 24:2;10

POINT #3: ALL SIN IS AGAINST GOD.

- **SIN IS AGAINST THE LORD. 2 SAMUEL 11:27**
-DESPISING THE LORD. 2 SAMUEL 12:7-9
- **DAVID NEGLECTED HIS RESPONSIBILITY.**
2 SAMUEL 11:2;15
- **OUR SINS EMBOLDEN GOD'S ENEMIES.**
