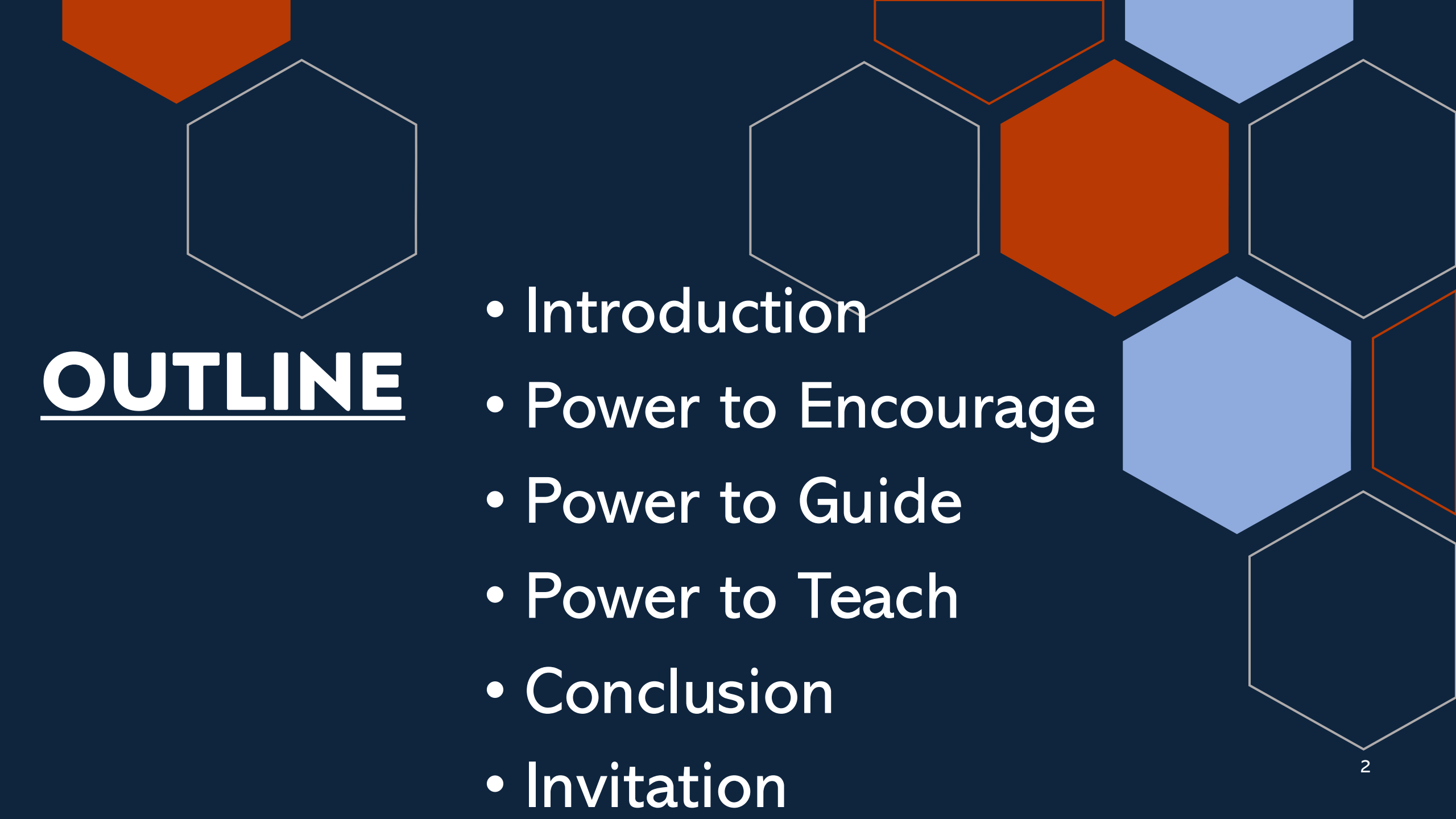

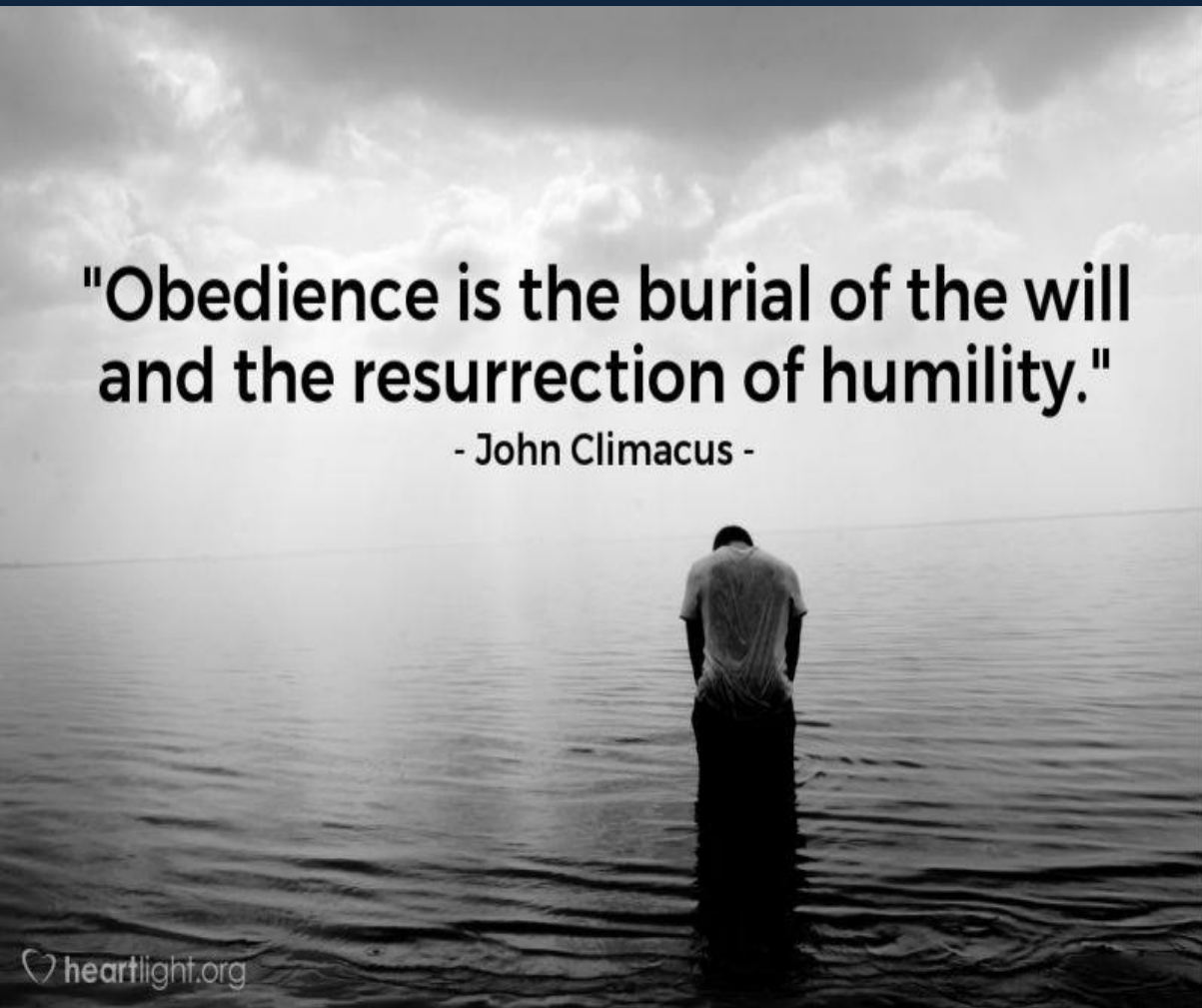

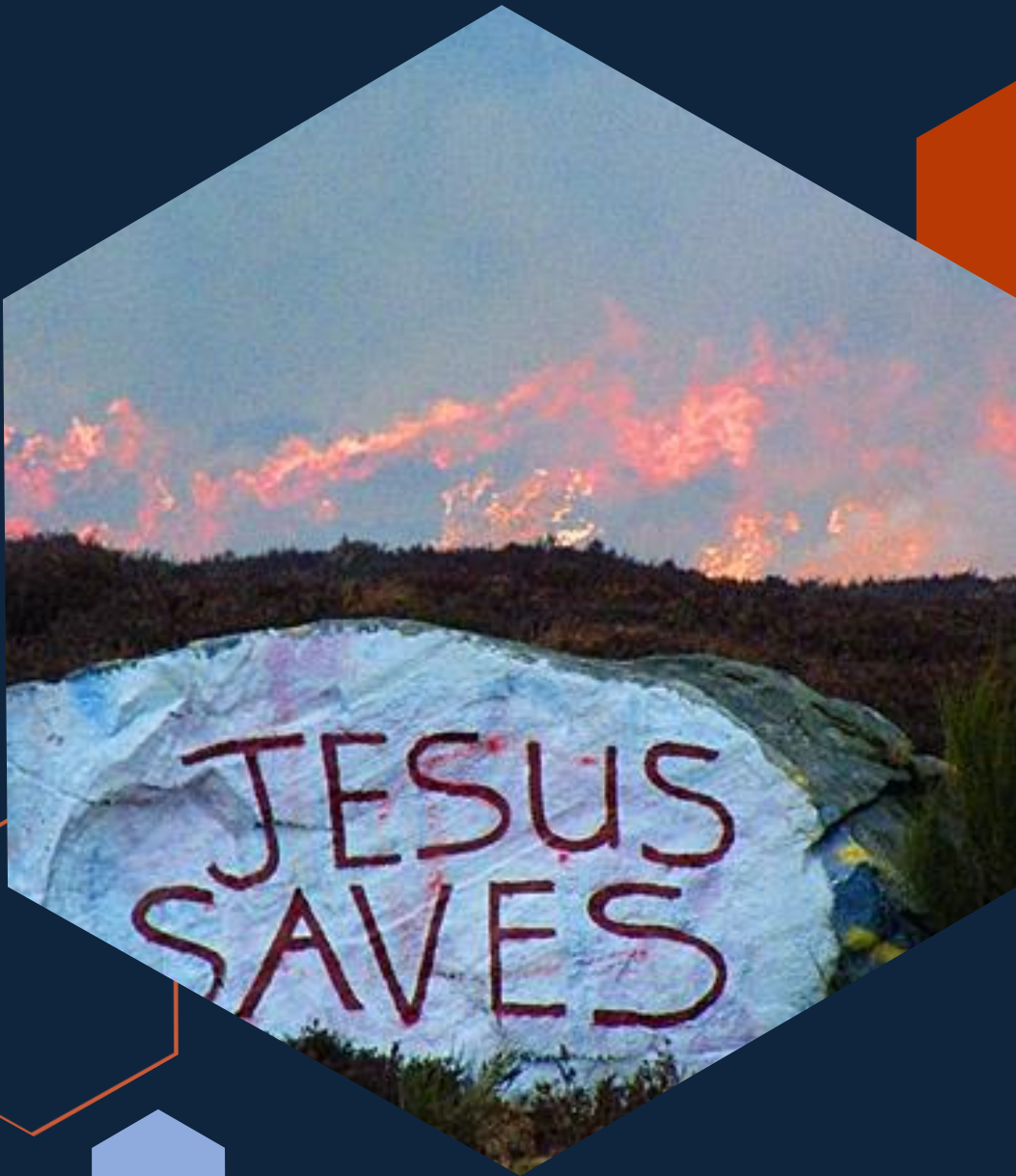
- To be saved
